Plan now to bring seeds from your favorite plants in jars, envelopes, or packets. Please include a label or instruction sheet with basic information: plant name, location (full sun, shade, etc.), flower color, bloom time (spring, summer, fall), and any specific planting or growing tips. A photo if possible!

Attendees come prepared with envelopes or zip lock bags to carry your seeds home.

When to Harvest Seeds? Once flowers begin to fade at the close of the season, most flower seeds are ripe for picking. Seed harvesting should be done on a dry and sunny day. Once seedpods have changed from green to brown and can be easily split, you can begin collecting flower seeds.
